# Executive Summary

---

The purpose of this research project was to document relevant information about an after school reading program. The program, known by the acronym, READ, was developed in 1999 by educators to provide additional opportunities for pleasurable and non-pressured reading time for selected primary grade students. With reliance on volunteer tutors and the support of the school staff and community, READ has continued to provide an early intervention and inexpensive model of reading support to emergent readers who, otherwise, would not merit individualized attention.

This research study was developed to:

1. Identify the essential components of the program's structure including reading resources;
2. Document evidence of students' growth (instructional reading levels); and
3. Obtain anecdotal evidence of volunteers' level of satisfaction.

The research study was conducted over two eight-week periods: September to November (2005) and January to March (2006). These time frames were selected to accommodate the participation of 18 pre-service teachers in the Faculty of Education at the University of Regina. Their involvement as volunteers was not

linked to any academic obligation. The remaining six adults were comprised of four seniors and two community residents who have an ongoing history of volunteering within the school community in addition to the READ program.

### ***SELECTION OF READERS***

Selection of readers adhered to the established pattern in the READ program with a focus on grades two, three, and four students in the fall session and grade one students in the winter session. Classroom teachers identified students who appeared to need extra time and support for independent reading. Further selection and screening was a consultative process between the classroom teachers and the learning resource teacher.

### ***PROGRAM STRUCTURE***

READ sessions were held twice weekly from 3:30 to 4:30 p.m. Each structured session began with a snack and a story read aloud by one of the volunteers or a guest reader from the school staff. Volunteers met with their partners and began their reading time by choosing leveled literature titles which were assigned a difficulty level according to Regina Public School System's established criteria

### ***DATA COLLECTION AND ANALYSIS***

Information was collected from three sources during the course of this research project. The first type of data came from informal and formal reader assessments. The second type came from the use of an oral questionnaire exploring readers' attitudes and self-awareness as readers. Finally, the third type of data was obtained from volunteers through a written questionnaire followed by an oral interview probing their experiences as READ volunteers.

The analysis of pre- and post- test results for all READ students confirmed growth for the majority of readers. For the eleven students in the fall 2005 session, the average gain was 3.2 levels (**see Appendix C**). For the fifteen students in the winter READ session, results indicated an average increase of 3.6 reading levels (**see Appendix D**). The highest gain was six levels for two students; two students (both identified and placed in a Special Education program) showed no change in reading levels.

Apart from the tangible evidence of reader gains, the READ program offered students personalized attention as they explored reading and enjoyed the informal conversation and interaction with a joyfully literate adult. In summarizing the results of this research, the original meaning of the acronym, READ, was revised from "Read, Eat and Digest" to "Read, Enjoy, Appreciate and Discuss". The new meaning reflected the four qualities of the partners' interactions:

- 1) **Time to Read** texts closely matched to the reader's actual/instructional level;
- 2) **Enjoyment** of the universal pleasures of shared stories and snacks;
- 3) **Appreciation** of the joyfully literate adult as a role model and guide; and
- 4) **Discussion**, which involves time to talk and create personalized and spontaneous connections between the books and their lives.

Ultimately, the aim of READ was to instill in all students the endless pleasures of books to read, enjoy, appreciate and discuss.

# Introduction

---

Seven years ago, three educators (a school principal, a learning assistance teacher and a university instructor) collaborated and created READ, an informal after school program to bolster students' confidence and interest in reading. The premise of the program then and now was to pair struggling or reluctant readers with caring and attentive adults for a mutually pleasurable and non-pressured reading experience.

Since that time, the READ program has endured with the ongoing support of school staff, community volunteers, and the students' families. No formal measures were implemented to assess the program's success. Some informal indicators of program's effectiveness included:

1. continuous involvement of key volunteers;
2. requests from parents for their children's participation in READ;
3. teacher observations of READ students' increased confidence and interest in reading; and
4. spontaneous verbal comments from readers expressing their enjoyment to teachers and volunteers.

This research study was initiated to identify the essential components of the program's structure as well as to document evidence of readers' gains and volunteers' satisfactions and suggestions. Volunteer participation ensures a low cost option for addressing the needs of emergent, at risk readers who otherwise would not merit individualized attention. It was hoped that with further analysis, the program would shed more light on the possibilities for offering early and low cost intervention programs to beginning readers.

The researchers involved in this study included a grade one classroom teacher, a learning resource teacher and a university instructor of pre-service teachers. The research was conducted within a community school of approximately 220 students (kindergarten to grade eight) located in a residential area of north Regina. For the purpose of this study, the 26 participants included seven grade one students, eight grade two students, seven grade three students, and four grade four students.

The research study was conducted over two eight-week periods that ran from September to November, 2005, and January to March, 2006. These time frames were selected to accommodate the participation of 18 pre-service teachers in the Faculty of Education at the University of Regina. Their involvement as volunteers was not linked to any academic obligation. The remaining six adults were comprised of four seniors and two community residents who all have an ongoing history of volunteering within the school community, including participation in the READ program.

# Literature Review

---

Research literature suggests that certain factors contribute to gains for struggling readers. Two conditions – early intervention and one-on-one interaction – provide a common framework for supplementary programs.

The importance of early intervention is thoroughly documented in the research literature as the most timely and efficient method of dealing with reading difficulties. Stanovich (1986) identified the Matthew Effect which suggests that students in first and second grade without a solid start in reading will read less and ultimately fall even farther behind their peers. Research supports the focus on beginning readers for optimal effectiveness of early intervention programs.

Apart from this critical time period, one-on-one intervention is frequently cited as an effective model for helping struggling children with reading difficulties (Allington, Shanahan, Wasik & Slavin, 1993). Typically, any one-on-one intervention involves specially trained tutors, which makes this preferred approach a labor intensive and expensive model for supporting at risk students. However, Brown et al. (2005) suggest that “literate and well meaning adults would respond intuitively and effectively to the needs of struggling readers.” Implicit in this statement is the potential value of adult role models to influence and shape the attitudes of struggling readers.

Flippo (1998) identifies discussion and dialogue as one of the eight indicators of effective reading instruction. The opportunity for interactive talk with a joyfully literate adult may be seen as another indicator of successful reading interventions.

The READ program applied these research findings in offering readers three essential elements of effective reading supports:

1. one-on-one attention with a reading role model;
2. selection of early readers and developmentally appropriate materials; and
3. opportunity to use discussion and dialogue to reinforce reading competencies and confidence.

Because this program was an extension to the school day and relied on volunteers without formal training as teachers or intensive training as tutors, there was increased importance given to the one-on-one time with an attentive adult.

# Research Methodology

---

## STUDENT SELECTION

Selection of readers adhered to the established pattern in the READ program, focusing on grades two, three and four students in the fall session and grade one students in the winter session. Classroom teachers for the designated grades were invited to provide names of students who were not receiving additional support but appeared to need extra time and encouragement for independent reading practice. Further selection/screening was a consultative process with the learning resource teacher and the classroom teachers. Once a list of potential students and interested volunteers was established, letters, including a consent form, were distributed to the students' parents/caregivers (see Appendix A).

To determine an optimal number of participants, two factors were considered: availability of volunteers and space constraints of the resource centre as the selected location for READ sessions. The number was accordingly determined to be ten to fifteen volunteer pairs.

## VOLUNTEER RECRUITMENT

Recruitment of volunteers also relied on the program's past history of success. Invitations were extended to previous volunteers, who were seniors, community residents, and retired teachers. Informational posters were distributed to all instructors of second year Language Arts methodology classes within the Faculty of Education at the University of Regina. All interested volunteers were invited to attend a school based orientation session prior to confirming their volunteer commitment.

During the orientation session, volunteers were provided a handbook that outlined routines, listed suggestions for responding to literature, and included a variety of reading prompts (see Appendix G). Informal conversation and constructive feedback was emphasized to promote a relaxed and positive experience for the reader. One of the experienced volunteers summarized the experience as follows:

*This was one experience for which I was totally unprepared, or so I thought. There was no intensive training program to ready me for the task. All I had to rely on were my wits, my love for reading, and some books graded to specific reading levels.*

## PROGRAM STRUCTURE AND SCHEDULE

Following the orientation session, at which an interest inventory was obtained from the participants, the researchers matched volunteers with students. At that time, the program session was outlined (see Appendix F) and the volunteer information handbook was distributed (see Appendix G).

READ sessions were held twice a week from 3:30 to 4:30 p.m. Each structured session began with a snack and a story read aloud by one of the volunteers or a guest reader from the school staff.

Immediately following the read aloud, volunteers met with their partners and began their reading time by selecting titles from book bins containing leveled literature choices. These selections were assigned a difficulty level according to Regina Public School System's established criteria. A comprehensive list of leveled literature resources is included in Appendix H. At the end of each session, readers were able to choose one title to take home to read and return at the next session. Specially made book bags were made and decorated to use as tote bags for the take home books.

Typically, the first activity was to have the students read their take home books to the volunteers. All books read were recorded in the students' reading logs. Each reader had a file folder that included a reading log, dated observations of session's highlights, and samples of response activities.

During the twenty to thirty minutes of partnered reading time, the volunteer and the student developed their own approach to using reading as an invitation to talk and naturally experience the mutual pleasure of sharing books. Suggestions were provided for response activities, which provided more autonomy for the volunteer, and choices for the reader, too.

The final ten minutes were spent returning materials, choosing take home books and preparing for the whole group share session. Volunteers took turns facilitating the session, and readers were invited to recap one of their highlights from the day's activity.

No restrictions were imposed in terms of the number of people speaking during the share sessions, since not all readers chose to share on the same day. Spontaneity and informality were emphasized. Often the items shared (e.g., bookmaking) provided inspiration for other readers. The focus of these sessions was a demonstration of the reader's feelings of success – confidence, pride and/or satisfaction – within a supportive group of interested readers and supportive adults.

## Data Collection and Analysis

---

There were three sources of information collected during the course of this research project. The first type of data came from informal and formal reader assessments. The second type used was an oral questionnaire surveying readers' attitude and self-awareness as readers. Finally, the third type of data was obtained from volunteers included a written questionnaire followed by an oral interview.

### **READER ASSESSMENT**

Pre- and post-testing included informal and formal tests. An informal oral reading inventory (running record) was used to determine student reading level placement and the formal Slosson Oral Reading Test was used to determine instructional grade equivalent. A comparative analysis provided evidence of growth or regression in reading levels, as shown in Appendices B and C.

An oral questionnaire (see Appendix D) included eight open-ended questions to determine readers' self-perceptions as readers. Responses were coded according to one key question: Did the student consider reading a pleasurable activity?

Initially, researchers intended to interview readers before and after the READ sessions. Following the initial interview, researchers observed difficulties in finding time and opportunity to conduct the interviews. Therefore, it was not possible to follow through with a second interview. As a result, data are limited to one interview and supplemented with anecdotal evidence provided in volunteer reflections.

## **VOLUNTEER SURVEYS**

The third data set is comprised of information gleaned from individual interviews with the volunteers at the conclusion of the fall and winter session (see Appendix E). Written questionnaires were distributed to all volunteers at the beginning and the end of the session. Volunteers were asked to respond to four questions in order to obtain anecdotal evidence of their level of satisfaction as volunteers and to solicit their insight and observations about the program's success.

## **READER CONTROL GROUP**

A control group was established in the fall to obtain baseline data of reader growth for students who were not participating in the READ program. Because of the highly transient nature of the school population, many subjects in the control group had moved, and as a result, more than half of the students in the control group were not available to researchers by the end of the project. Therefore, comparative data was available for the fall session only.

## **ADDITIONAL ASSESSMENT**

In the original design of this study, questionnaire/interview surveys were included for classroom teachers and parents/caregivers of READ participants. As the research progressed, data originating from students and volunteers seemed more relevant to the purposes of the study. Due to the limited opportunities to meet with teachers for oral interviews and the challenges associated with parents' voluntary completion and return of written interviews, this component of our research study was not carried out.

# Research Findings

---

The analysis of pre- and post-test results for all READ students confirm growth for the majority of readers. For the eleven students in the fall 2005 session, the average gain was 3.2 levels (see Appendix C). Six of these students increased three reading levels over the course of an eight week program; three students made gains of two levels, with the lowest gain being a one-level increase for two readers ( both students were later identified and accepted into a Special Education Program).

The fall control group of thirteen students showed an overall increase of 1.7 levels with an average gain of two levels for most students (7); the highest gain was four levels for one student, and two students' scores showed no change in reading level.

Of the fifteen students in the winter READ session, results indicated an average increase of 3.6 reading levels (see Appendix D). The highest gain was six levels for two students; two students, who were both identified and placed in a Special Education program, showed no change in reading levels. No data are available for the control group.

Apart from academic gains, readers showed increased interest in reading, which is reflected in one volunteer's comments:

*At the beginning of the program my student was more interested in drawing and coloring than actually reading the books...during the fourth or fifth session I asked my student if she wanted to draw a picture about her favorite part of the story and she replied by asking if she could keep reading that day.*

Reader enjoyment was implicitly expressed by the students who often expressed their reluctance to stop reading and get ready to go home. One volunteer observed that "every time we meet B always asks how much time is left because he doesn't want to go home." Another volunteer's comment confirms this by saying that "it flies by and you wish that the time wasn't up." Feedback from all volunteers includes the suggestion that more time be given for one-on-one reading time as well as extending the duration of the session beyond the typical six to eight weeks.

Implicit in this suggestion is the mutual enjoyment generated by the pairs reading time, which was also articulated by a volunteer:

*I am hooked on the program...because it is just a simple thing that amounts to one hour out of my day twice a week. But what an hour! It is one of the most satisfying and gratifying things I could be doing with that time.*

Volunteers describe the READ environment as having a "positive atmosphere that encouraged children no matter what their attitude." Comments such as "welcoming and non-threatening" with "only a genuine welcome and we're glad you're here and here you go..." were also statements confirming volunteers' appreciation of a relaxed and friendly atmosphere.

Although the students were not able to articulate their gains as readers, the volunteers expressed their appreciation of their partners' growth and change as readers. One volunteer commented that she watched "the light go on as he (reader) shared a book with a smile on his face." Another volunteer has the following explanation for the shared pleasure at these breakthroughs to reading success:

*This experience allowed me to see the smaller steps that a student makes before coming to the "light bulb" moment. This was rewarding as well because you feel in a small way that you were part of that success.*

Finding pleasure in books was one of the first accomplishments of the READ participants. Connecting that interest to writing activities was a frequent occurrence among students. Some students found their own reasons to write ("...he wrote me a note and said he would miss me and he had fun at READ") while other students became authors by creating their own stories and books. The school's vice-principal, who is also a classroom teacher, summed up the experience as follows:

*The most exciting change that occurred with these students was how their attitude toward "books" and "reading" changed. All of a sudden it was a chosen activity that they knew they could have success in...it helps kids develop skills as well as feel successful and empowered while they are doing it.*

# Conclusion

---

Apart from the tangible evidence of reader gains, the READ program offered students personalized attention as they explored reading and enjoyed the informal conversation and interaction with a caring and attentive adult. The unconditional acceptance of the students was eloquently expressed in one volunteer's words: "I loved working with the kids as works in progress and wanted these kids to know that they mattered."

The original meaning of the acronym for READ (Read, Eat and Digest) was revised to **Read, Enjoy, Appreciate** and **Discuss** to reflect four key elements of this research study.

1. Time to **Read** remained the focal point of the READ program. Using developmentally appropriate literature closely matched to the reader's instructional level provided a comfortable fit and in turn, promoted confidence and success for the students. Beyond the students' compatibility with the text level, this time allows a reading experience outside the confines of classroom instruction. In this context, a pleasurable and positive reading experience promotes increased awareness and appreciation of literacy. By reading the word, there were increased opportunities for students to "see the world" beyond the imposed boundaries of community.
2. **Enjoyment** represented the pleasures that readers and volunteers derived from their time together. READ sessions begin with predictable yet comforting rituals associated with pleasurable reading – a tasty snack and the shared anticipation of time together to read, talk with volunteers and students, and make personal connections through books.
3. **Appreciation** involved the close relationships that develop between tutor and student. These personal connections were a significant factor contributing to the volunteer's satisfactions and continuing involvement with the program.

Shaping the mutual feelings of appreciation was the volunteer's attitude that s/he enjoyed reading, valued their times together and acknowledged the student. Most importantly, the volunteer took the time to get to know the unique personality of the reader.

4. Finally, **Discussion** allowed the reading partners to use talk in making connections between the books and their experiences. The words on the page became more than symbols to decipher; they had meaning and links to the real world that could be explored and examined through interactive talk. Conversation, not questioning, begins the dialogue between readers and provides an invitation to read.

Ultimately, READ aimed to instill in all of its students the endless pleasures of books to read, enjoy, appreciate and discuss.

*...All I had to do was share one of my loves with them – the love of reading. Sometimes I was met with a little balking or self-doubt. But with a bit of commonsense and some ingenuity, reading came about through playing a game, singing or me being the scribe as the child's imagination came to life. It didn't matter how they learned to read but READ THEY DID!*

The students will receive a snack, listen to a story, and then work one-on-one with a volunteer developing reading skills and strategies.

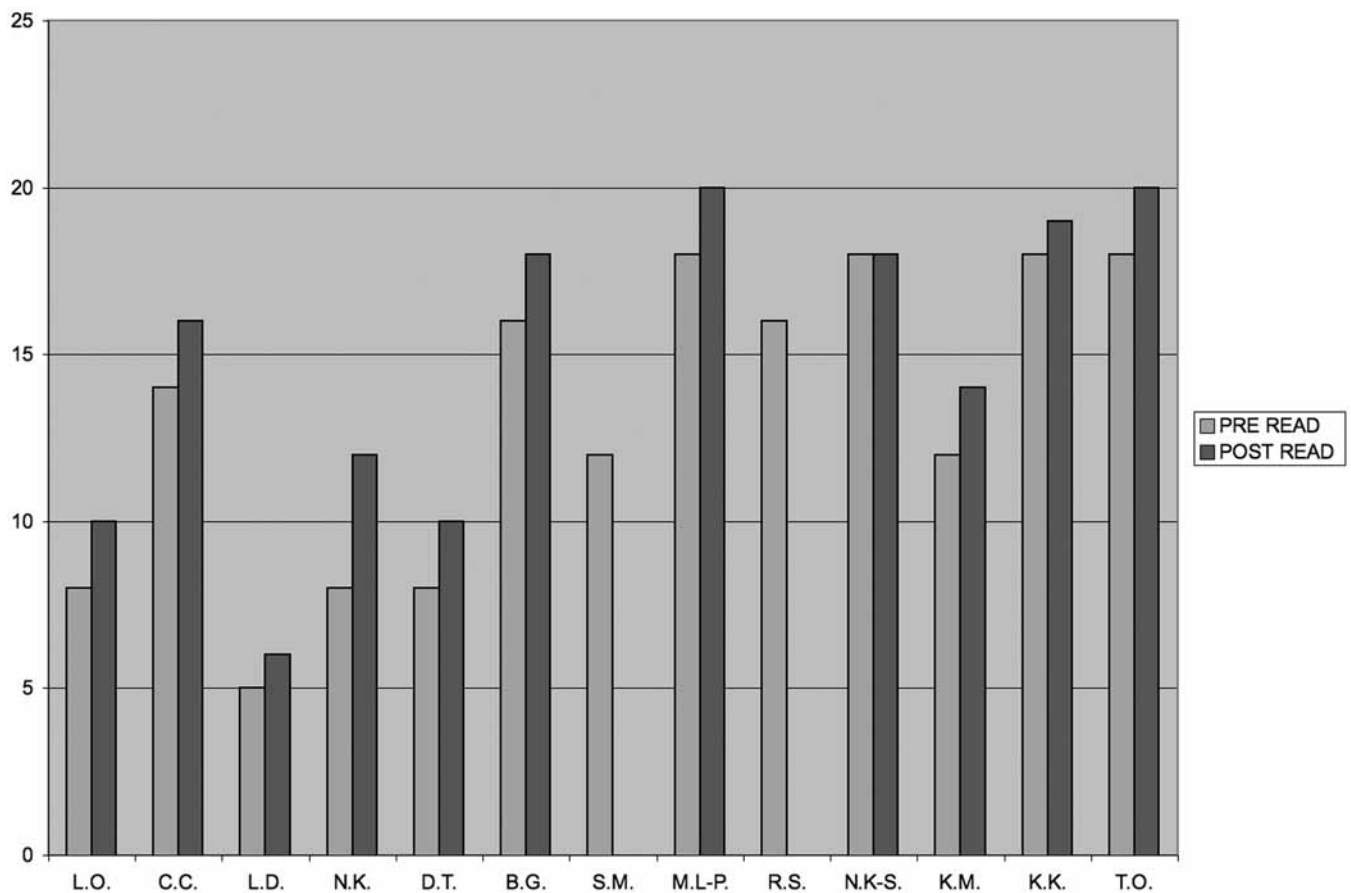

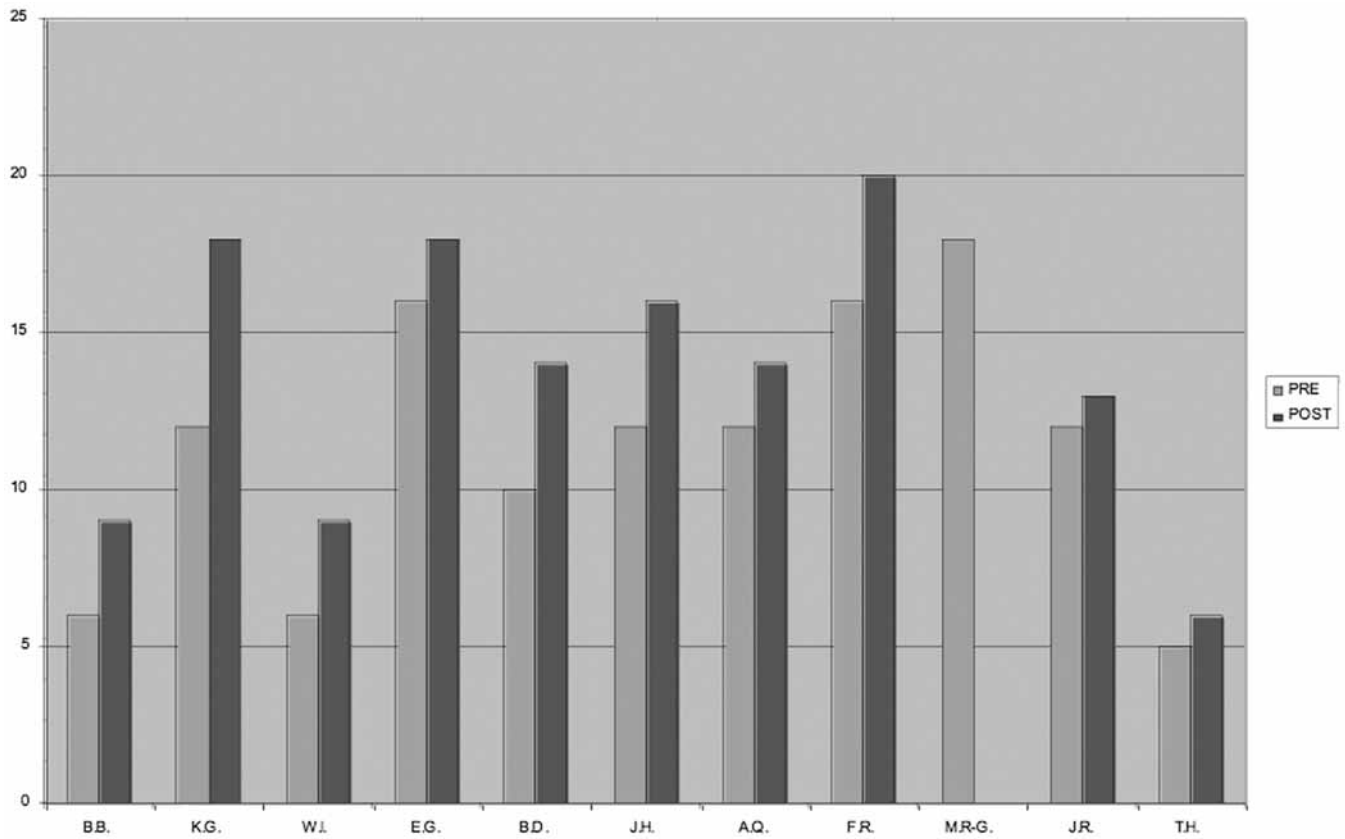
# Appendix B: Pre and Post Test Results: Fall Session

**PRE AND POST TEST RESULTS FOR READ PARTICIPANTS: FALL SESSION**



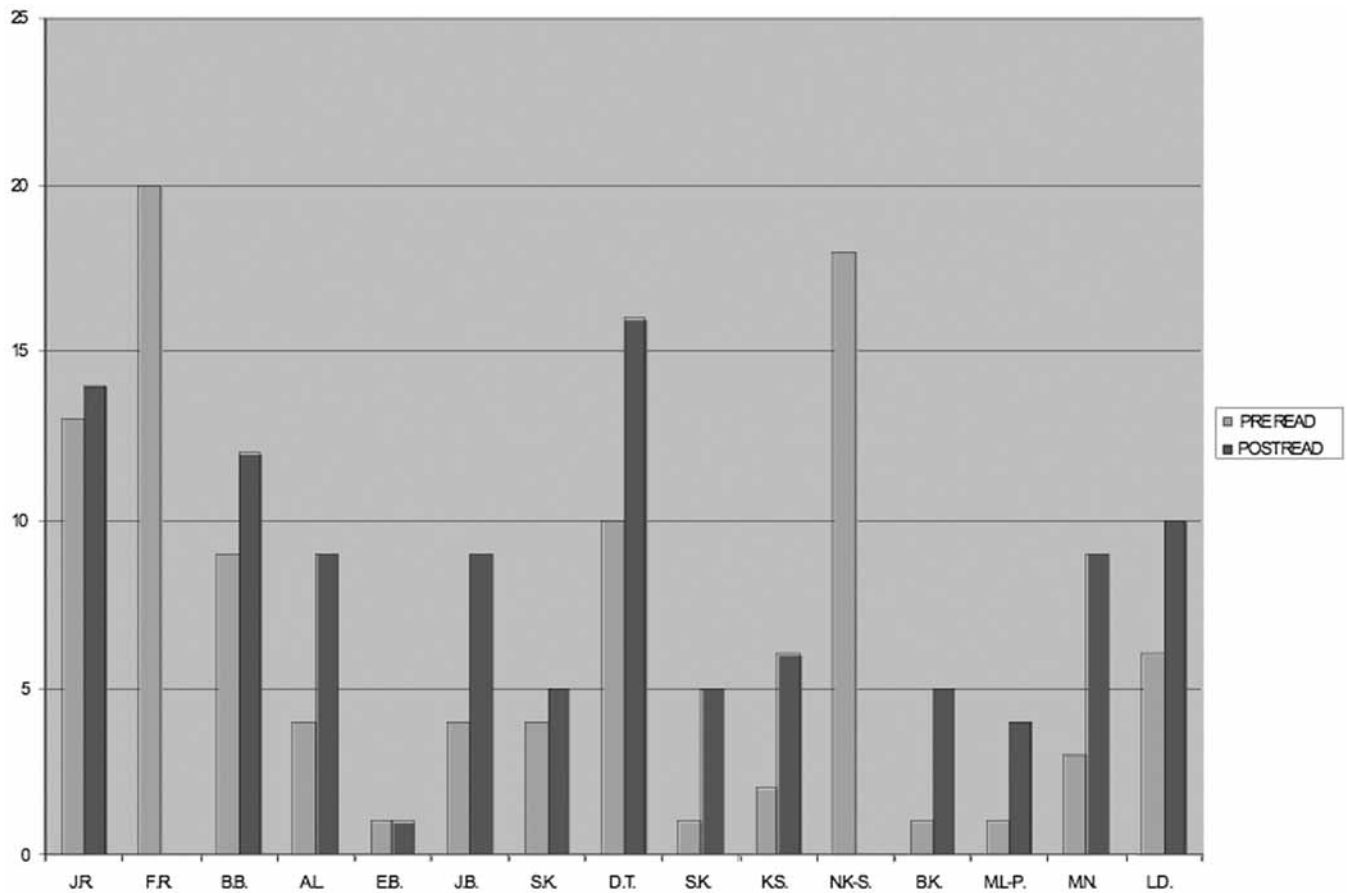
**FALL READ GROUP**

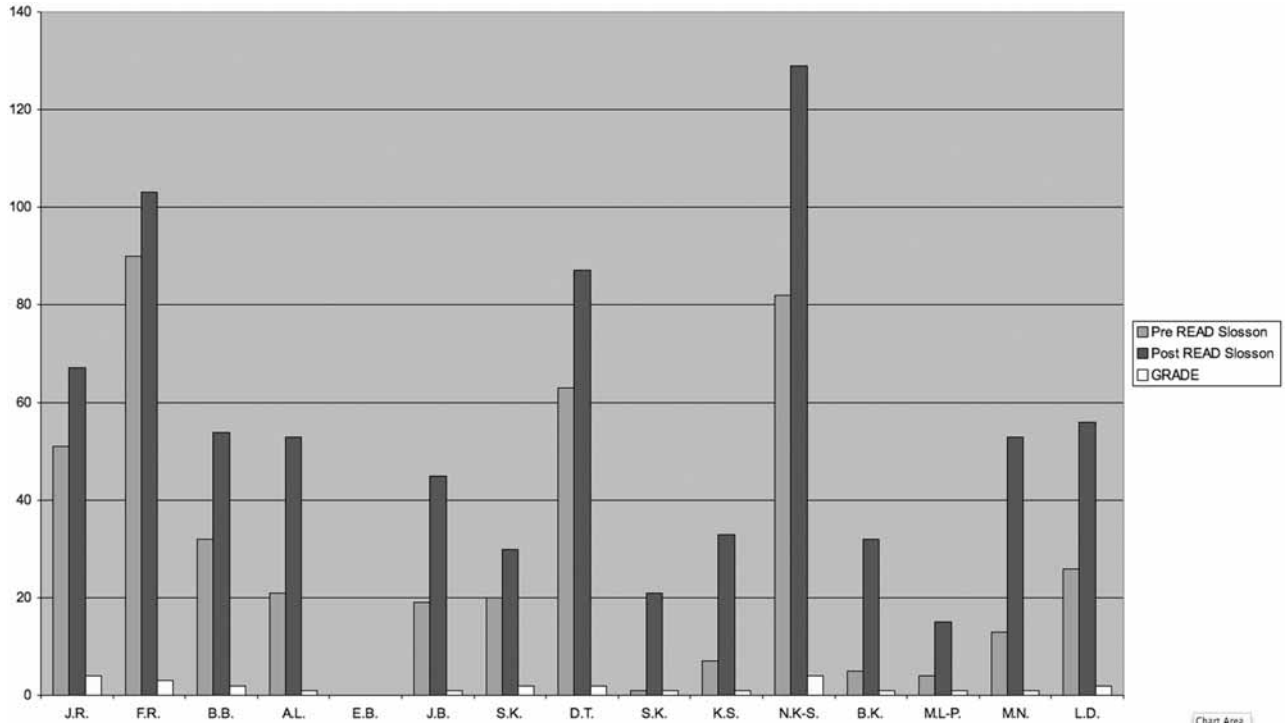
## *PRE AND POST TEST RESULTS: WINTER SESSION*

Pre and Post Test Results for READ Participants: Winter Session



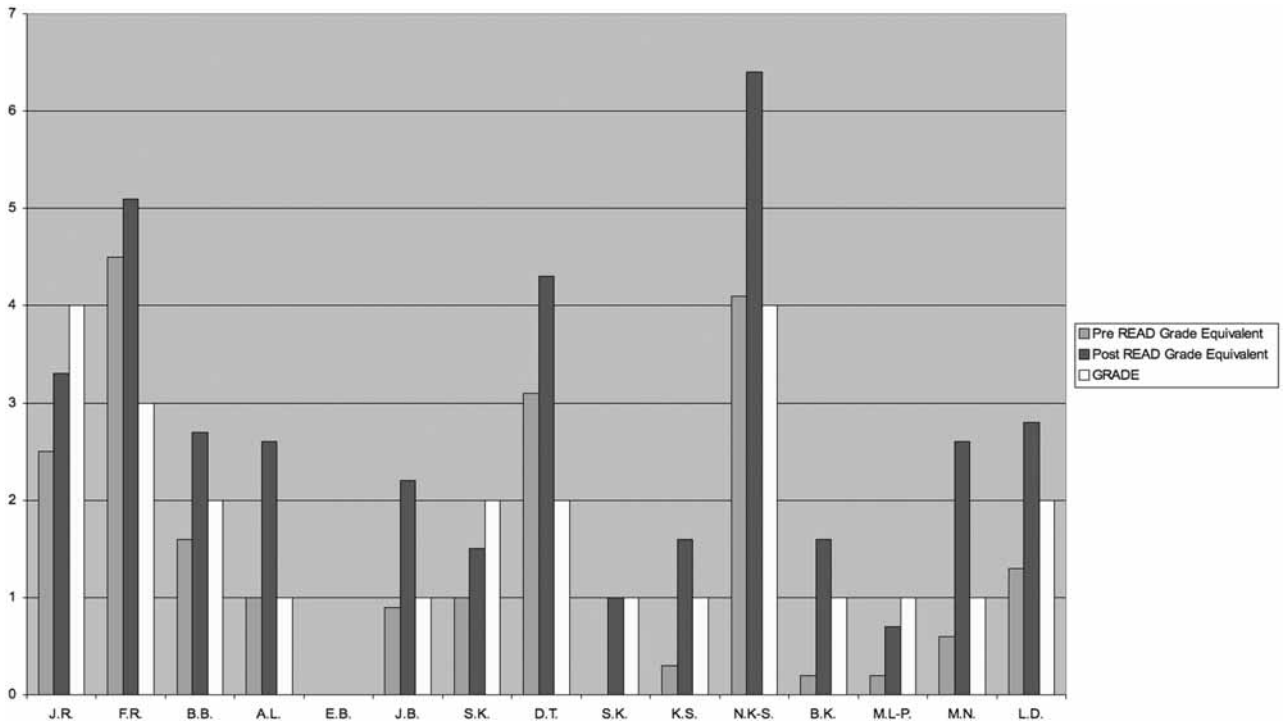
WINTER READ GROUP TEST RESULTS

# Appendix G:

## Volunteer Information Handbook

---

### INTRODUCTIONS

Beginnings are scary for everyone: students and readers. Keep this in mind and remember that the purpose of these sessions is to provide a pleasurable and non-pressured reading experience. Here are some suggestions for making sure the reader is relaxed and receptive to this reading time.

**Mutual Respect:** Let the reader know you are there to enjoy reading together with reassurance that you value what s/he already knows about reading.

**Trust:** Explain that reading together is a priority for you and that you will be looking forward to this routine.

**Time:** Take the time to listen and talk with the reader. Spontaneous conversations are an expected and valued part of your time together.

**Enjoyment:** Remember that the most important purpose of this time is mutual enjoyment of books and each other.

### READING TIME

**Sit side by side to enjoy the story. Take time to talk about the story by:**

- Reading the title
- Looking at the front and back cover
- Enjoying the illustrations
- Taking a picture walk through the pages talking about the illustrations

**Use a “pause, prompt and praise” technique** to provide encouraging feedback when your reader comes to an unknown or difficult word

- Pause...wait 5 seconds before you jump in to help
- Prompt ...ask questions which help reader figure out word
  - Did that sound right?
  - Does that make sense?
  - What do you think would make sense here?
  - Can you find something on the page to give you a clue?
- Praise...Offer encouraging words for attempting to figure it out.
  - Good work or Good try.
  - That’s almost right. You’re close. Close enough.
  - Right on. That’s right.

- You worked out the hard part – good for you!
- You tried lots of strategies to figure out that word. That’s what good readers do!

**Encouraging words to help reader figure out new or unfamiliar words:**

- Look at the picture to help yourself. What clues do you see?
- Think about what word would make sense here?
- Look for chunks or small words like “it” or “at”
- Does that word make sense? Does it sound or look right?
- Try again.
- Skip the word and go to the end of the sentence. Now what word makes sense?
- Can you point to...? Can you find where it says...”

**SUGGESTIONS FOR RESPONDING TO THE READING:**

Avoid interrogation (question/answer) but invite reader reactions and comments about the story.

- Write a sentence about the story after or before drawing a picture.
- Write a list of favorite words from the story.
- Reread the story.
- Make a book patterned after the story.
- Take a sentence from the story. Cut it up. Have students rearrange the sentence using strategies to get meaning.
- Make sentence strips for the book and arrange in order.
- Pick a word from the story and make word families – e.g. mat, pat, bat, rat, sat etc.
- Make a word puzzle with one of the new words - r \_ \_ d \_ \_ g
- Write out the title, author, and illustrator. Explain in one sentence what you liked or didn’t like about the book. Use sentence frames such as My favorite part was or The best thing about this story was or I liked this book the best because
- Create a bookmark including an illustration with the book’s title and author.

**WRAP UP ON A POSITIVE NOTE:**

Always end the session on a positive note with specific feedback. Think about what your reader did well and tell them - e.g. “I noticed you were able to remember all the words on your word ring.” Record that comment in the reading file for reader to read next time.
